2022 brings us to our **tenth year** of offering the **Award in Literacy and Dyslexia (ALD)**. Each year, we keep up to date with the latest research and evidence-based practice so that we can bring you the most recently published information on literacy difficulties and dyslexia, and guide you through well-developed strategies on assessment and intervention. We are also excited to launch our first year of the course in **Afrikaans** to support Afrikaans learners with literacy difficulties. MORE ABOUT THE ALD COURSE

The ALD is an 18-month part-time course that is open to teachers, speech and language therapists, occupational therapists, and psychologists who have two years experience of working with school-aged learners. The course provides a deep understanding of literacy development, literacy difficulties, and dyslexia. It also provides participants with tools for the assessment of literacy difficulties and risk for dyslexia and provides evidence-based intervention strategies with the support of individual tutoring. The course is offered through a blended learning model, consisting of virtual lectures and online coursework. Access to high-speed internet is required. Participants can register for the full course or per module. Each module builds on the previous module and can be taken within a two-year cycle. Accreditation is as follows: 90 CEU (level 2) + 30 CEU (level1) awarded by HPCSA. 5 Ethics Points apply. 45 CPTD are Awarded by SACE.

MEER OOR DIE TGD KURSUS

Die TGD is 'n deeltydse kursus wat oor 'n 12-maande tydperk aangebied word. Dit bestaan uit twee modules wat aan deelnemers die opsig bied om een module op 'n slag te neem, of die volledige 12-maande kursus. Hierdie kursus verskaf onderwysers/ onderwyseresse, skoolleiers, terapeute en sielkundiges met dieper insig oor hoe lees ontwikkel. Dit maak gebruik van die nuutste nagevorsde metodes vir die onderrig van lees en geletterdheidsvaardighede. Deelnemers sal blootgestel word aan siftings-instrumente, verslagskrywing en intervensie metodes met skoolgaande leerders wat lees en geletterdheidsprobleme het. As deel van hierdie kursus, is daar 'n praktiese aspek waar die deelnemer 15-uur intervensie moet toepas onder die toesig van 'n persoonlike tutor. Die kursus is aanlyn en kan onderneem word vanaf enige plek in Suid-Afrika of oorsee. Aansoek omakkreditasie deur die 'Health Professionals Council of South Africa (HPCSA)' en goedkeuring deur die 'South African Council of Educators (SACE)' sal gedoen word.
