




Dear parents

COVID protocols update

In keeping with the recent changes scrapping the mandatory use of masks and the lifting of restrictions at events and gatherings, we have considered our protocols and make the following adjustments with effect 4 July 2022:

- The wearing of masks at school is optional.
- For the winter term, we strictly require that your child should **stay home if he/she is presenting with any sickness** or brewing symptoms of any sort. The children and teachers are all emerging from an unusually sterile environment, and COVID or not, all the environmental contagions are rife and we seek to avoid extended teacher/therapist/learner absences due to ill health.
- Sanitiser will be provided at school and strongly encouraged on site.
- We will revert to **one access gate** for Grade Two Grade Seven at the start of day and at home time. This will create some slow traffic and short-lived congestion and we call upon your patience. Please do come a few minutes earlier or arrive a few minutes after the actual close of daytime to assist. 'Park left and pass right' will serve us well.
- Grade One access and departure remains at their playground.



- Parents will be invited to **attend assemblies by invitation** of the class teacher, should your child be getting an award or acknowledgement.
- **Spectators at sports matches** resumes without specific invitation.

After winter, and once the children are settled into their new routines, we will revisit free flow access to the property.

Winter School



You may notice a bevy of visitors on our property – these are children enrolled to the five-week reading intervention we call 'Winter School'. At Winter School, we work an intensive phonics and RAVEO programme to get that reading going! The children are here from 08h30 - 13h30 and wear blue, branded hoodies for easy identification.

They attend Monday to Thursday and while there is no daily interaction with the enrolled Bellavista children, they will join us for any fun event.
