



Learning difficulties exist together. Research shows that conditions like dyslexia and dyscalculia co-occur, demanding an approach to learner support. The Award in Remedial Education provides educators, specialists, and practitioners with a deep understanding of learning needs and equips you with tools to assess and design effective evidence-based interventions.

This course consists of four modules. You can choose a pathway with a focus on dyslexia and literacy, a focus on dyscalculia and numeracy, or a stream covering both.

You can complete the course through one of two pathways. The distance learning pathway requires 5 to 8 hours per week dedicated to lectures, reading, and online tasks. Alternatively, delegates can opt for the Block Module Intensives, where module content is delivered during study blocks scheduled throughout the year. Additional reading and assignment preparation time applies to the blocks.

Progress is supported through short understanding checks, while each module ends with a summative assessment. Modules are completed sequentially, meaning completion of each module is required before progressing to the next module.

The course is accredited by the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA) for health professionals and endorsed by the South African Council of Educators (SACE) for educators. Delegates who choose the literacy and dyslexia focus qualify for accreditation with the British Dyslexia Association (BDA) at a Level 5 Teacher/Practitioner status.

Admission Requirements

- Qualification: 3 or 4 year professional teaching or therapy qualification or equivalent.
- Experience: A minimum of two years of educational or therapeutic experience in an educational context/ working with children.
- Valid SACE or HPCSA registration
- Supporting Documents:
 - Certified copies of your ID, qualification certificates, and SACE or HPCSA certificates.
 - CV or letter confirming your educational or therapeutic experience.
 - Clearance certificates (or proof of application thereof) for the Sexual Offenders Register and Child Protection Register (required for practical Modules 3 and 4).

Application Process

- Step 1: Go to www.bellavista.org.za, click on Train at S.H.A.R.E., and select Remedial Education Course.
- Step 2: Pay the non-refundable R500 application fee to receive a link to the application form and document upload portal.
- Step 3: Wait for your documents to be reviewed. Successful applicants will receive an Enrolment Contract and further payment information.

Course Fee is inclusive of

- All textbooks, file notes and primary reading materials.
- Delivery of the course through a combination of face to face block intensive sessions or live lectures and online course work.
- Academic support.
- Individual tutoring/ mentoring for the profiling and intervention modules.
- Assessment tools and training on the tools.
- Access to various journal articles, publication websites as well as a subscription to a reading intervention website.
